

The entire school ambience is student friendly.

Co-scholastic Activities:

The school has always believed in complimenting the academic component and enhancing the overall educational experience of students through a wide range of co-scholastic activities like literary activities, dramatics, art & craft, dance, music, trips & excursions etc.

Library:

Books feed our souls. School has maintained a library that is well stocked with books (fiction, non-fiction, poetry, prose, encyclopedias), periodicals, journals, national dailies etc.

Internet Access:

The school's internet access runs as a controlled system. School offers protection from inappropriate material through a filtered system providing only safe and curriculum based websites. Students can have an easy access to internet whenever required.

Sports Academy:

School has a vast playground which includes 100m standard track, football, hockey, khokho and a cemented basketball court. Our students are given swimming lessons by a well trained swimming instructor in a HALF OLYMPIC sized swimming pool that graces the campus, which is in itself a one of a kind in the area. Our Sports Academy trains the students in skating, football and basketball from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm.

Student Council

To develop leadership skills, organisational ability, self-confidence, personality, sense of responsibility and diligency, students have been divided into four houses namely - Discovery House, Harmony House, Legacy House and Unity House. Activities of these houses and other events of the school are headed by a STUDENT COUNCIL comprising Head Boy, Head Girl, Secretary, Sports Captain and House Captains.

School Transport:

The school has an excellent transport arrangement for students. A fleet of 11 buses are available to cover a number of routes. Trained drivers and a female attendant looks after the safe journey of our students. All the buses have GPS and CCTV facility.

Medical Facility:


A visiting doctor comes to the school. In case of emergency the child is taken to a renowned hospital of Raikot by a responsible member of staff and parents/guardians are informed immediately.

Registration and Admission

- O Admission is open to all boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed or social status, provided they are mentally and physically fit, having attained the minimum age of three years.
- O Application forms for registration to all classes are available at the school office.
- Entrance tests are held in the month of March. Results are declared according to merit and admissions are made subject to vacancies.
- Name of the child can be registered for admission from Nursery to Class IX. At the time of admission the parents are required to submit to the school, a birth certificate from the Registrar of Birth for admission to Nursery Class. An affidavit will not be accepted, proof of address and school learning certificate.
- Students migrating from other schools must submit Transfer Certificate, School Leaving Certificate and Progress Report from the previous school.
- Registration does not guarantee admission, incomplete forms may be rejected.
- The Principal reserves the right of granting or refusing admission to anyone who seeks admission to school.

Withdrawal

- If a child is withdrawn during the school session, a prior written notice of one month for withdrawal must be given, failing which fee for the said period will be charged.
- Those who plan to leave after the academic session should inform the school in writing by 28th February, failing which fee for one month will be charged.
- Those who submit their applications for withdrawal in March shall have to pay the annual charges and the dues for the month of March.
- Students who are withdrawn from the school in the month of May (before the summer vacations) must pay the fee for the month of June.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued and the security deposit will be released on the clearance of all school dues. Security refund is done within a month of the request.
